The 2018/2019 ATV Registrations and stickers are now available. ☐ If you are registering an ATV for the first time, please bring in a bill of sale or proof of sales tax from a dealer at the time of registration. ☐☐ Renewal fee for residents is \$34.00 and \$69.00 for non-residents. ☐☐ First time registration for residents is \$35.00 and \$70.00 for non-resident. ☐☐ ATV's DO NOT require a title.

Boat Registrations DO NOT require a title. ☐☐ If you are registering a boat for the first time, please bring in a bill of sale or proof of sales tax paid from a dealer at time of registration. ☐☐ Registration fee is based on length of boat and horsepower.
